2023 BBYC FUNDRAISING

BBYC works hard to keep our registration costs manageable for families and keep the fees in the lower third of the other towns in our league. This is only possible because of the fundraising efforts by you, our BBYC families. The 2023 season will have three mandatory fundraiser responsibilities.

CALENDAR RAFFLE

Each football player and cheerleader are responsible for two raffle books (\$100 value). Families with multiple participants will receive a reduced number of books per child. Please check with your TEAM PARENT for details.

Please Note: Members could pay to opt out of the raffle fundraiser (\$100) when registering child.

TAG DAY

Each football player and cheerleader are responsible for two hours of tag day slots. Tag Days this season are September 1-3 and September 29 – October 1. Athletes need to complete two hours in the time slots available. Time Slots will be available on Sign-up Genius, which will be made available soon. Please check with your TEAM PARENT for details.

Please Note: Members could pay to opt out of the tag day fundraiser (\$50) when registering child.

SNACK STAND DUTIES

In addition to the rising costs of uniforms, equipment, league fees and insurance it costs BBYC over \$1100 (referees and trainers) every home game we host. We operate a great Snack Stand to help offset these costs. We need our families to work the Snack Stand to make this happen.
